**New Bellevue University students who have graduated at any time with an associate degree from a Texas community college are eligible. Students must initially enroll full time (8 credit hours) per term to receive a grant for the tuition paid for a Texas community college associate degree, up to 60 credit hours, at the student's specific community college's 2020-2021 tuition rate. Amount awarded cannot exceed Bellevue University's 2020-2021 tuition rate.

The grant will be divided and applied to Bellevue University tuition cost during the first, middle and final terms at Bellevue University. The grant is non-refundable, covers tuition charges only, and does not include the cost of fees, books, or other expenses incurred while at the community college. This offer may not be combined with other Bellevue University grants. Guild and Corporate Partner students are not eligible.

*Consult with an admissions counselor to determine your eligible credits, as well as to verify minimum graduation requirements for this degree. Transfer credits must be from a regionally accredited college or university. Bellevue University makes no promises to prospective students regarding the acceptance of credit awarded by examination, credit for prior learning, or credit for transfer until an evaluation has been conducted.
